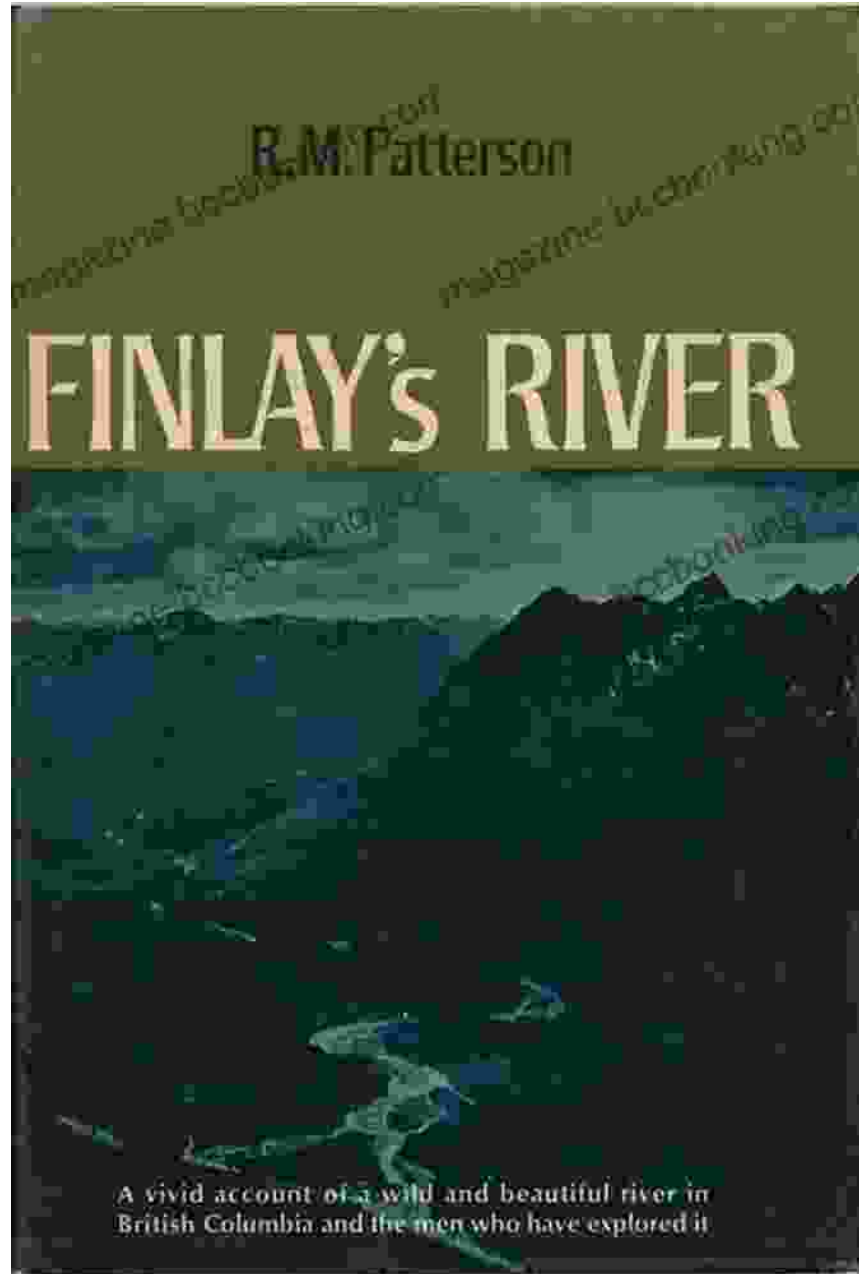


Finlay River Patterson: An Unforgettable Journey of Love, Loss, and Redemption

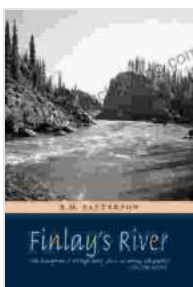


Synopsis

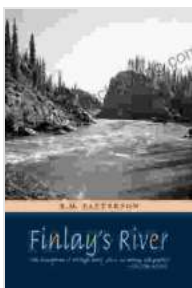

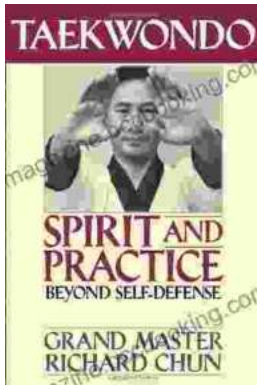

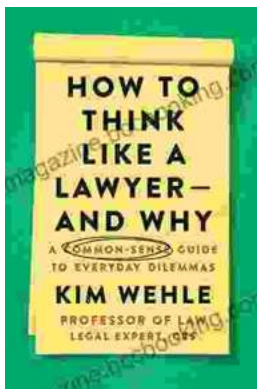
