VENOMOUS



Timber Rattlesnake

Crotalus horridus

- Recognized by a tail rattle, a broad head, large pupils (not pictured), and vertical pupils.
- Adult length: 3.5-4.5 feet.
- Typically a yellowish color with brown or black bands down its back.
- Found in deciduous forests and rugged terrain.
- Hibernates in rocky crevices and dens.
- Endangered in several Northeastern states: VT, VT, MA, and ME.



Tail PI

NON-VENOMOUS



Eastern Hognose

Heterodon platirhinos

- Distinguished by an upturned rostral (snout) pit, lack of tail rattle, and round pupils.
- Adult length: 3-4.5 feet.
- Variable coloration can be speckled yellow or all black.
- Found in woodlands with dry sandy soil.
- When threatened the hognose will flatten its neck and bring its head up off the ground.
- It may also play dead.



Copperhead

Agkistrodon contortrix

- Recognized by a copper-brown and yellow/black, dark brown/picture, and vertical bands.



Eastern Milk Snake

Lampropeltis triangulum

- Distinguished by a "V" or "W" on the top of its head, expandable, a lack of tail rattle, and rounded pupils.






