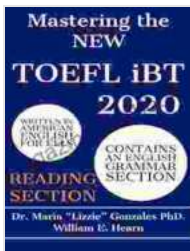

- **Vocabulary questions:** When you are answering a vocabulary question, first try to define the word based on the context of the passage. If you are still not sure what the word means, you can use a dictionary.

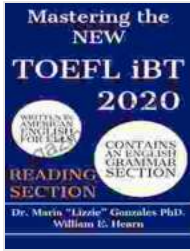

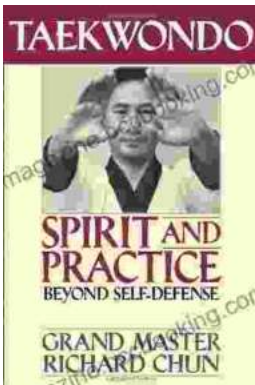
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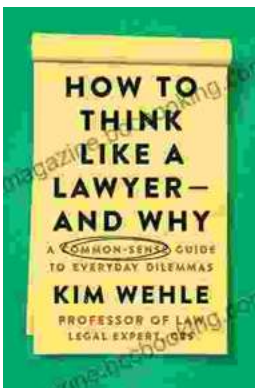
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
